Harlingen Bands Earn Top Awards at Pigskin Jubilee

The Harlingen High School and Harlingen High School South Marching Bands received a Division I (superior rating) as all of the bands from Brownsville to Donna squared off this weekend in the Annual Pigskin Jubilee. A score of 1-1-1 was given by a panel of three judges for both high school marching bands.

Roger Harms, HCISD Director of Music said, "Work began early in the summer in preparation for this contest. Many hours are spent in the band hall and in the practice field perfecting their performance routines." Harlingen High School's marching show is called "Powered by Metal" with a theme of "Music of Metallica" while Harlingen High School South's program is called "Themes from James Bond 007."

These top ratings come on the heels of other invitational competitions in Robstown and Donna. Both Harlingen marching bands ranked in the top 5 bands at the Robstown Invitational in early October. Harlingen High School South finished 4th competing with bands from all across South Texas. Harlingen High School finished first in all categories including Best Percussion Line, Best Drum Majors, Best Color Guard and Best Overall Musical Performance.

The Hawk and the Cardinal Band will perform this weekend in the Bands of America contest in San Antonio at the Alamodome.
